Students!

- We will all be performers and we will all be audience. The audience is a fully participating part of the theatre. We are all expected to be an active part of the audience.
- Memorize lines in scripted pieces! Study your role.

Parents, your students will need:

A few objects. If you have questions, let us know!

Good reading skills and ability to complete assignments outside of camp. We are committed to including students of all abilities, so if your student is not a grade-level reader or needs other types of accommodations, let us know.

A way to prop their devices so we can see as much of their movement as possible. This can be a tripod, but it can also be something you rig at home.

Students may need headphones or a mic to avoid feedback and improve sound during the performance. If you have them, have the students start using them right away. If not, we'll work around it.
